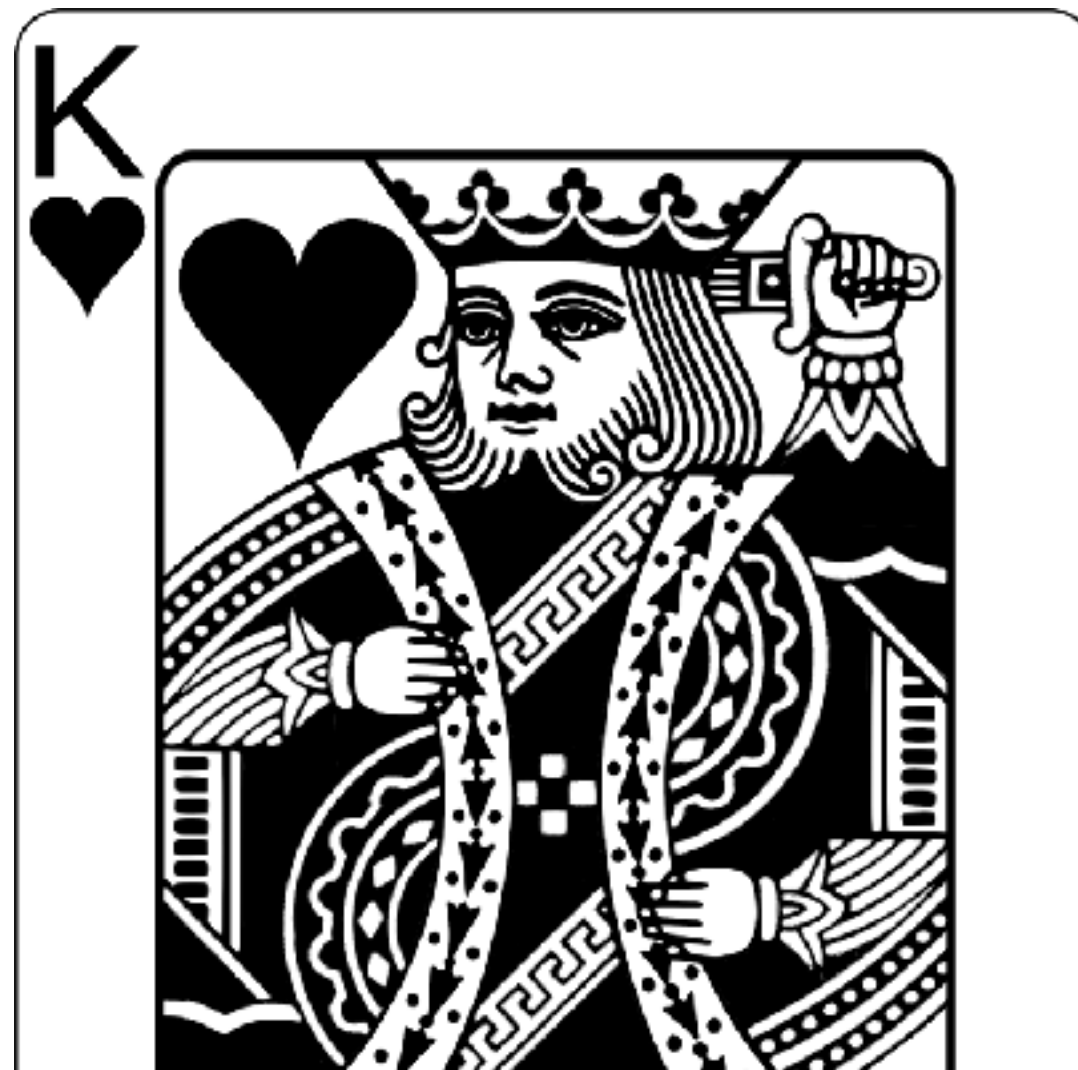

Macro-planning: Sitemap

- Home
 - About
 - Contact
 - News
 - Services
 - What we do

Macro-planning: Sitemap

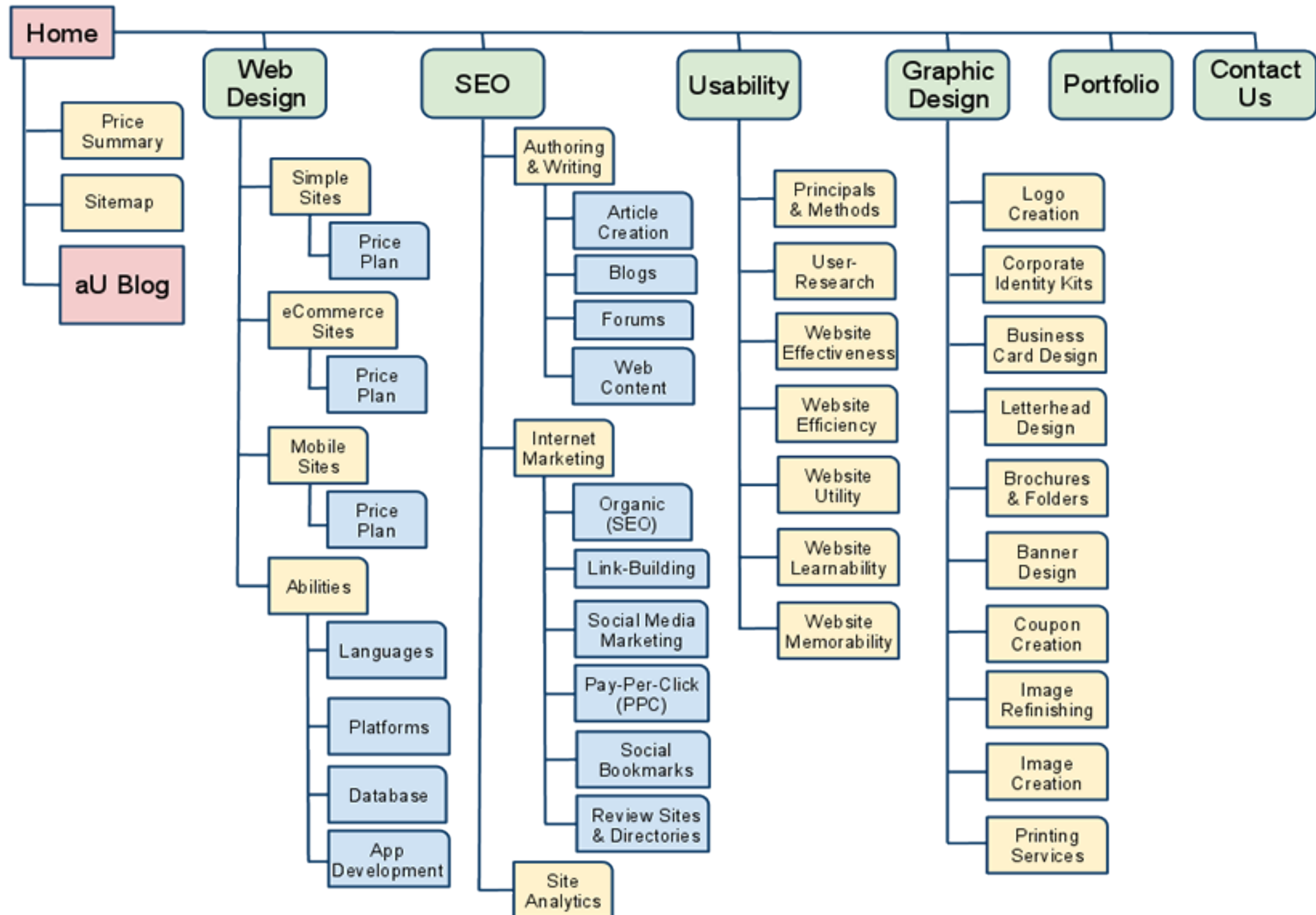
- Describes broad website structure
- Great for navigation and hierarchy
- Lacks content type description
- Lacks development hints

Macro-planning

Visual sitemap.

A hierarchical list of pages,
drawn as a diagram.

Macro-planning: Visual sitemap



Macro-planning: Visual sitemap

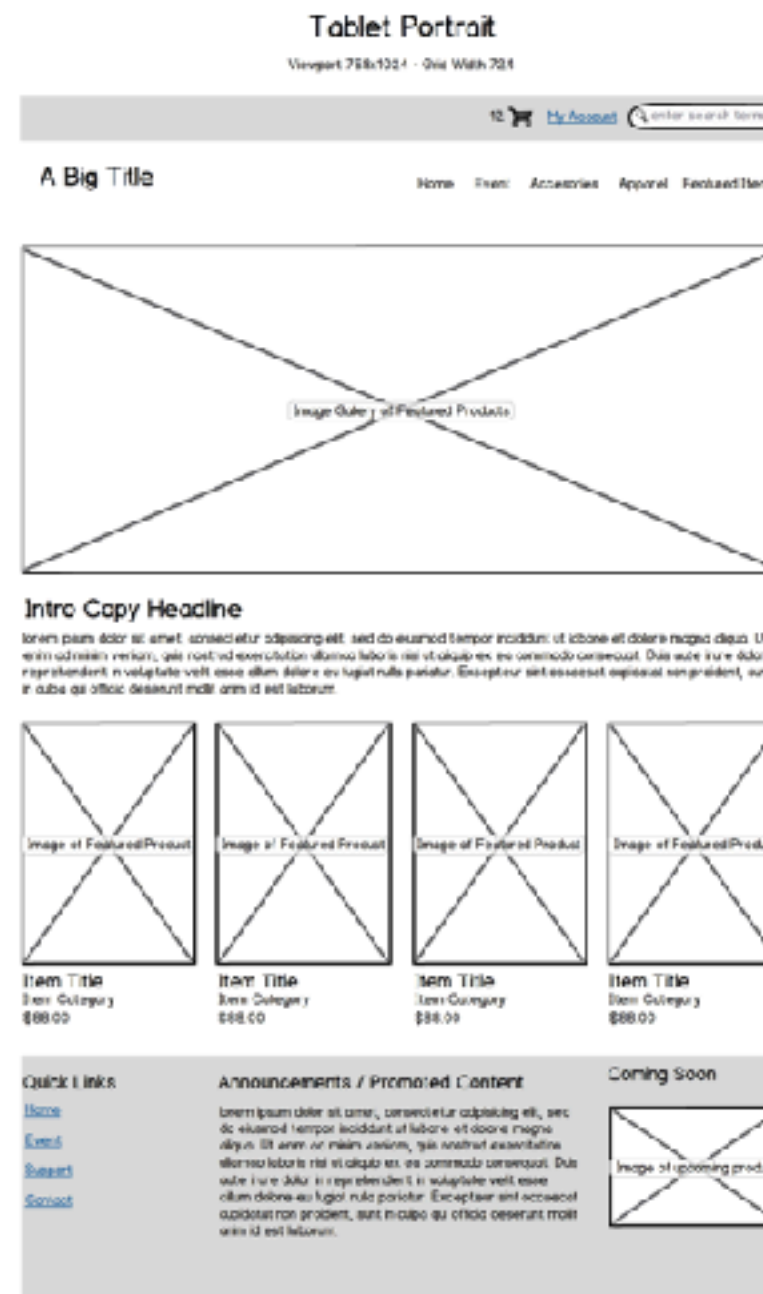
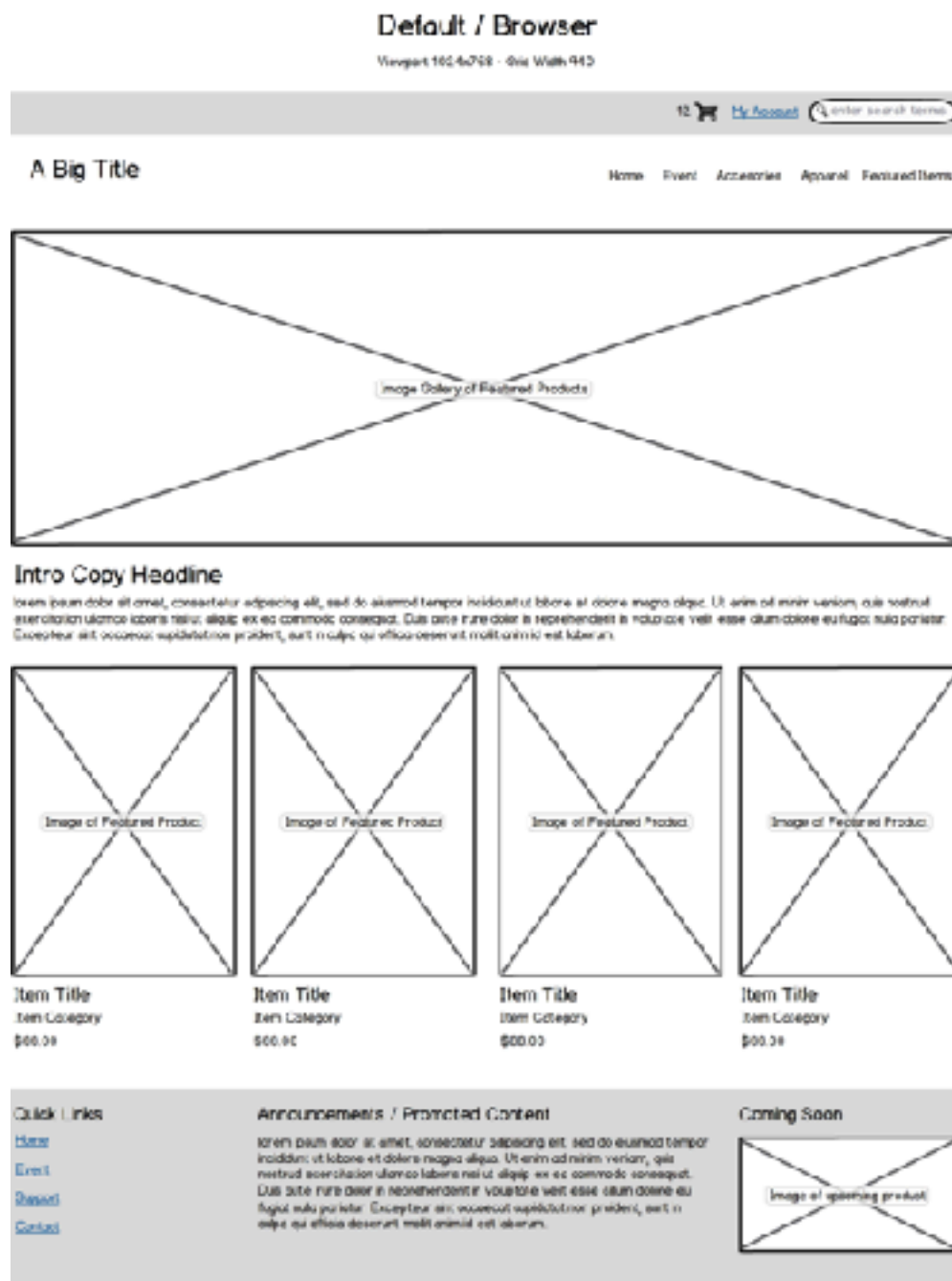
- Displays structure and relationships
- Great for categorization and grouping
- Still lacks content type descriptions
- Difficult to express associated content relationships

Macro-planning

Wireframe.

An image or set of images displaying functional elements of a webpage, typically used for planning a **site's structure** and functionality.

Macro-planning: Wireframe



Macro-planning: Wireframe

- Displays page structure and element relationships
- Shows relational proximity and content areas
- Implicitly describes content descriptions
- More functionally related than content descriptive

Not done.

Content planning does not stop at a sitemap and a wireframe. The content has been barely described at all.

Micro-planning: Types

- Identifying content entities can be tricky
- The types of content you create are discretionary
- Wordpress comes with some content types ready to go out of the box.
 - Posts, Pages, Categories, Media are all examples of different content types each with shared and unique properties.

Identifying Content Types

- Does an individual item belong to a collection?
- Does an item exist on its own?
- Does an item have unique information?
- Does an item have a group, or affiliation?

If you answered yes...

You have a prime candidate for a content type.

If you were anybody alive in the 90's, you could escape the knowledge of the unstoppable force that is The Power Rangers. A teenage fantasy of kicking evil's butt while looking cool, it was insanely cheesy, but did well in branding and selling toys. Now, with Hollywood having remade virtually every 80's movie property, we are transitioning into remaking the 90's. Shockingly, it's not half bad.

So it's not a disaster, but then again expectations weren't insanely high. This is a high school movie starring beautiful people (Zach Efron 2.0 is front and center) all building to a giant battle between robot dinosaurs and a monster made of gold. All that really matters is if we had a good time watching it. Thanks to some slick camera and character introductions, director Dean Isrealite (Project Almanac) gets things moving quickly by giving us some entertaining dialogue and well-choreographed car chases. The film does a good job of building towards the inevitable moment when our heroes can finally morph, that it almost proves to be a rushed disappointment when they do (I want more bonding and fight montages!) Camp and cheese abound, but not to the point of parodying itself, which is refreshing to see that the director seems to have such a confident hand on the material.

As Hollywood continues its trend of remaking every decade of pop culture (Animaniacs and Speed remakes coming up?), we can breathe a small sigh of relief that it seems actual effort was put into this big screen version of the Power Rangers. Sure, it's a pretty dumb movie, but considering the source material we could simply have gotten a Transformers clone remake that would have made some money and then been forgotten. Power Rangers actually tries to flesh out its fab-five, making them relevant to teens today and giving us someone to invest in under the suit when the robots come out to play. It isn't perfect, but it proves to be a heck of a lot of fun.
